

The Florida Water Resources Act of 1972 that divided water management in Florida among five water management districts was a major step forward towards the goal of sustainable multipurpose water systems. Tom Swihart presents a unique perspective on the accomplishments and remaining challenges for water management in Florida with emphasis on changes since the 1972 Act. The recently retired Administrator of the State Office of Water Policy describes the unique nature of each of the five water management districts. He addresses long-standing policy questions such as charging for extracting water that have been proposed on numerous occasions and the wasteful
