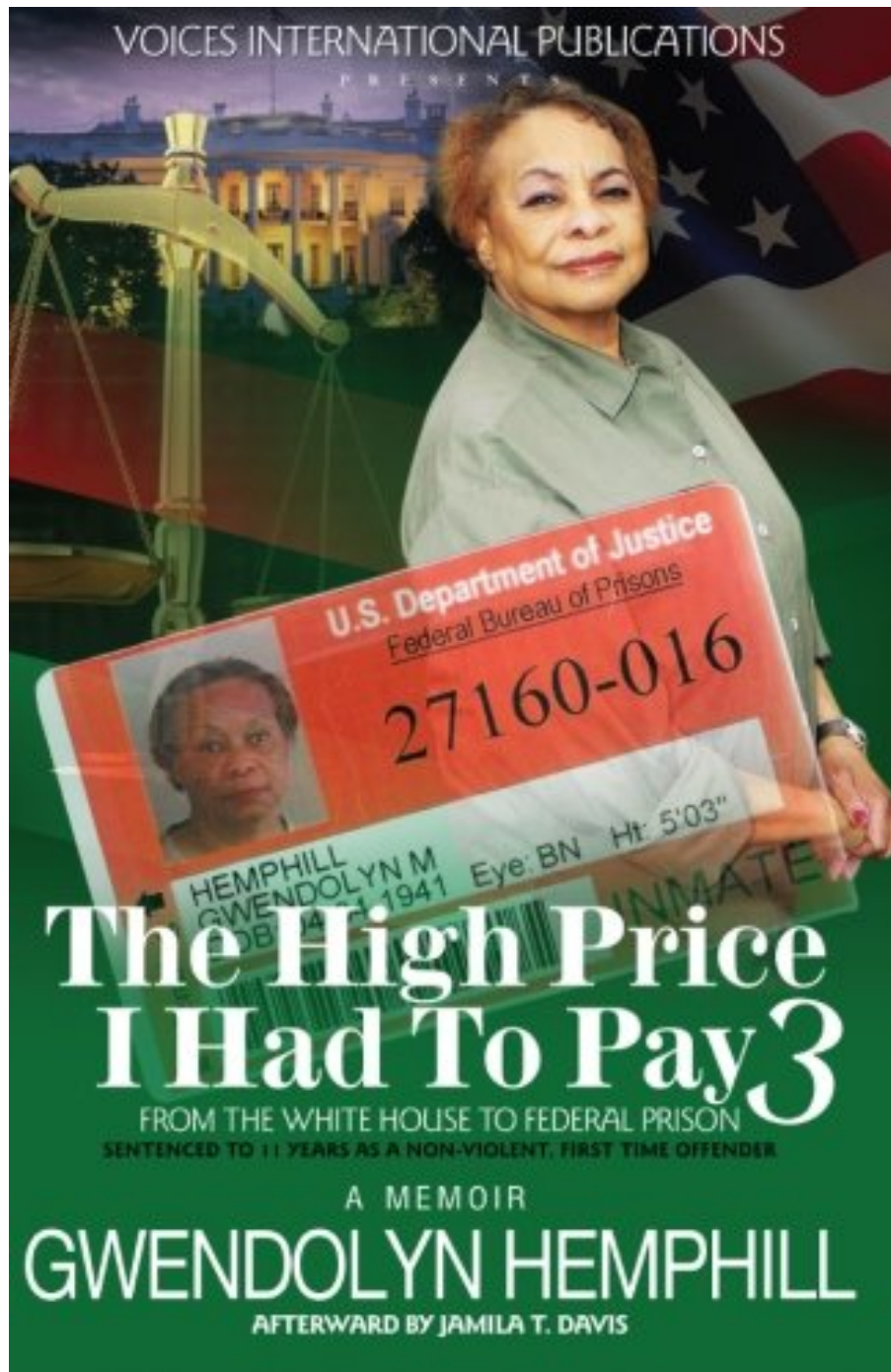

Wow! I am honored to be the first one to review this amazing book. . . it is a story of such inner strength that I am honestly "blown away." I got it in the mail, opened it up and really never put it down. There was something so compelling about Gwendolyn Hemphill's story. . . her story . . . not an excuse, but an openness of who she is and how anyone can end up in prison garb with the cell locked behind them. Most of us have done things that we were not aware of the consequences or the severity and by pure fortune, have not had to pay the price. This is a story of how dearly Gwen Hemphill has paid the price. It's a tough story but a truly inspiring one.

I have had the privilege of meeting Gwen Hemphill ... Ms. Gwen as she is lovingly referred to within the correctional setting. I was part of a ten-month mentoring class as a co-facilitator and Ms.Gwen was one of initially ten women that formed the roundtable. Of course, a couple of women dropped out as is usually the case, but Ms.Gwen was a faithful participant in the program. She graciously waited for us at the door to the 'camp' and served us anything that we desired to make our hour and a half comfortable. I was inspired and most impressed with her ambition; not for herself but for those in need. She is a doer and sees that there is a lot to be done and steps up to the plate to see it happen. She would set up our classroom and kindly usher us out for the next class as she thanked us for giving of our time to come to the prison. I really don't know if she believed me when I told her it was an honor to be with these wonderful women. In all honesty, they changed my life and added a dimension to my heart that is now filled with those precious souls with whom I shared

those fleeting forty weeks. Since I live close by, my heart still sinks with sadness as I miss those great ladies.

I did not know Ms. Gwen's personal details as we were in a class with a particular agenda and I didn't really need to know anything but sharing these life principles and helping these women to see their untapped potential and help them to understand themselves better. In helping them, they helped me. I will cherish that time forever.

This book written by Gwendolyn Hemphill is a peak behind the curtain or in this case, peeking through a crack in the hard thick cold prison walls that keep them hidden from real sight. It tells of lengthy incarcerations for white collar crimes with no chance of parole. Hard core criminals get out faster and earlier. The saying: "Let the punishment fit the crime." seems to be ignored in the sentencing of these women who are doing three times as much time incarcerated as the male prisoners. Who knows that? Do you? I don't think many of us have a clue how this system is being run. . . well not until now. And this is why this is a story of glory. It is a story of a woman that did not change who she really is . . . she made a mistake, but she stood strong in the face of great adversity and changed not only hundreds of lives while incarcerated, but is planning on changing a system.

I am not ashamed to say that I am not so sure I could have been put behind bars at 65 years old and made it through as Gwen Hemphill has done. She told herself the truth (that she had this seemingly insurmountable mountain ahead) and decided that she would be true to herself with trust in her God and is now coming forth with a backbone of steel regardless of her physical ailments she is a force to be reckoned with . . .

Like a modern day Joseph (coat of many colors Joseph) she was placed in prison but just like Joseph decided if prison is where life takes place, then life will keep on going and the prison will be better for it when she leaves. I cannot tell you everything Gwen has done for the community and for those precious women in prison but she is adored among the population and held in great esteem for her constant love and kindness toward these broken and hurting women. many who have had to leave their families and young babies behind . . . Gwen was the comforter giving out of her own need, she comforted others.

You have to read this book. It is not long but it's power-packed. I have no doubt that we shall see Gwen center stage in the future. She is a gracious and lovely lady with charm and class and lotsa peppery spunk. . . let's face it, you'd have to have tenacity to go to prison at 65 and face 11 years behind bars and come out swinging like a female Rocky Balboa.

We need to know how our sisters are being treated in the judicial system. The bible says, "My people perish for lack of knowledge." I do not want to see anyone perish or suffer extensively when it is not a fair sentence. I would want someone to come to my defense if I was pretty much defenseless and seemingly forgotten hidden away from the public eye.
